Olivier Millagou. Taking its name from a 1970s movie about surfing, Five Summer Stories casts the fun-inthe-sun surf culture of Hawaii in a darker light. French artist Olivier Millagou is not satisfied with the clichés about the islands: instead, he situates the exhibition at night, painting the walls black with white stars. A soundtrack of ukuleles playing funeral dirges gives a corny morbid atmosphere to the phosphorescent paintings of kitsch pop iconography of surfing, sunsets and tikis.
