Olivier Millagou. Taking its name from a 1970s movie about surfing, *Five Summer Stories* casts the fun-in-the-sun surf culture of Hawaii in a darker light. French artist Olivier Millagou is not satisfied with the clichés about the islands: instead, he situates the exhibition at night, painting the walls black with white stars.
